

# Own Your Own Cattle

## Payments & Terms

### Available Animals:

- Yearling Waygu/Angus Steers and Angus Steers
- Yearling Angus/Brangus Heifers

*All animals are grass fed, grass finished, antibiotic free, and do not contain hormone implants.*

### Available Grazing Terms:

- Steers- 6 months or 1 year
- Heifers- 1 year with ability to renew annually

### Payment Breakdowns:

#### Cost to purchase cattle:

- **Steers:** Castrated male cattle intended for beef
  - **600 lb. Yearling Waygu/Angus Steers- \$2.20/lb.**
  - **600 lb. Yearling Angus Steers- \$2/lb.**
  - 2 payments to purchase steers: **Initial payment** for the steer then a **final payment** due at the end of the term based on the steer's finished weight. Yearling steers are estimated at 600 lbs. Steers are weighed on scales and the end of the term to get their finished weight.
    - **Final Payment Example:** Your steer's initial purchase weight is 600 lbs. and if the steer's finished weight is 900 pounds, *your final payment* would be based on 300 lbs. (900 lbs. finished weight - 600 lbs. initial weight = 300 lb. difference)
- **Heifers:** Young female cattle for raising calves
  - **Yearling Angus/Brangus type Heifers-** \$1400 per heifer
  - **2 Year Old Bred Angus/Brangus type Heifers-** \$1800 per heifer

#### Monthly Cost for Cattle Care

- All cattle incur a monthly charge of \$60 per head to cover your steer's/heifers' grazing, supplements, and health monitoring.

### Additional Services:

- *Included:*
  - 2 tickets to our Quarterly Ranch Working Days and 2 tickets to our Spring & Fall Cattle Working Days
  - *Individualized Coaching* regarding selection and management of cattle, agriculture resource and technical assistance guidance, connections to local farming/ranching networks, agriculture funding source guidance, marketing your beef guidance
  - *Assistance* with finding and scheduling your steer with a local processor
- *Delivery* of your steer to the processor (additional cost)
